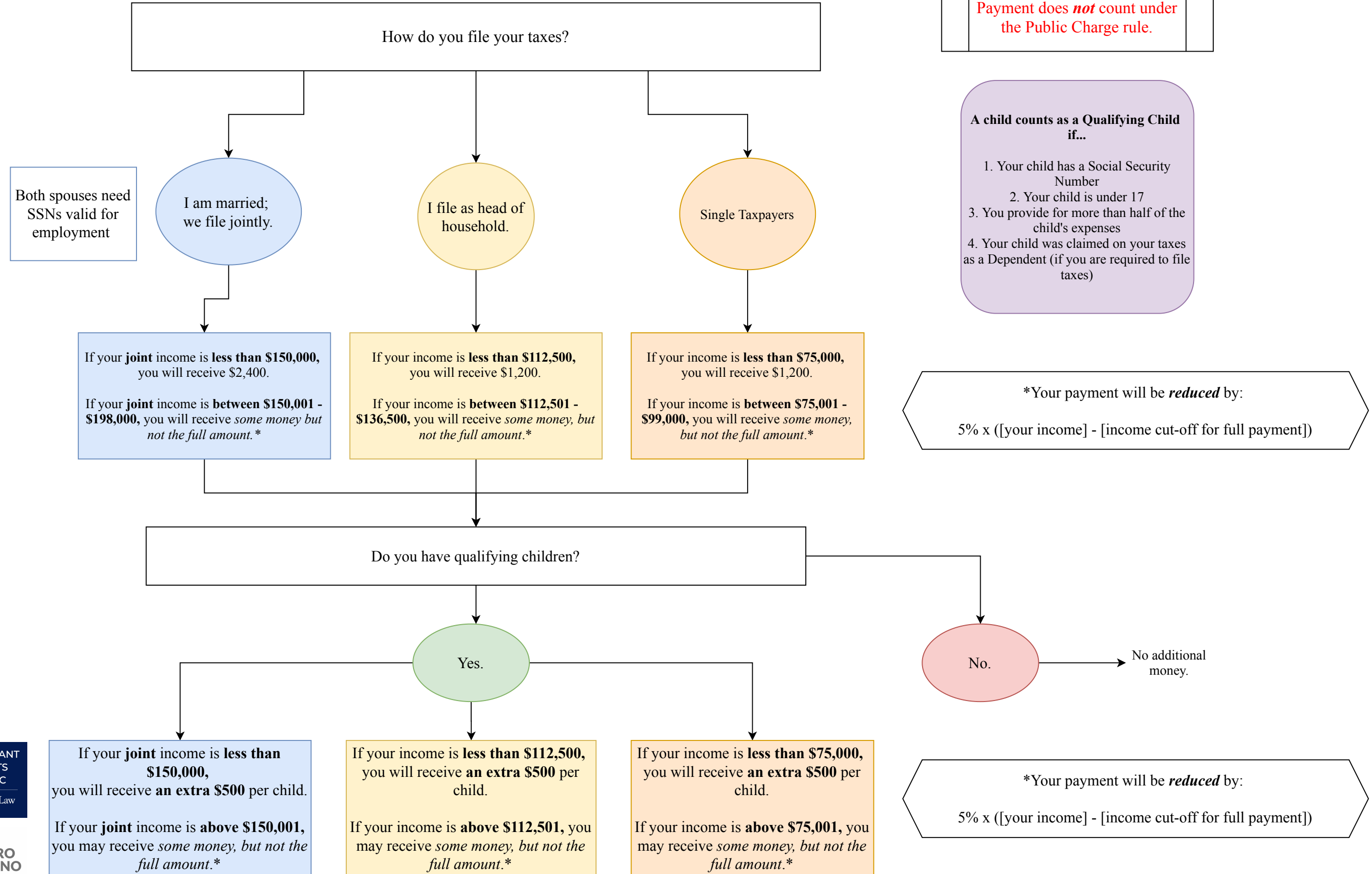


Economic Stimulus Payments

Diagram 2: How much money will I get?



Receiving an Economic Impact Payment does **not** count under the Public Charge rule.

A child counts as a Qualifying Child if...

1. Your child has a Social Security Number
2. Your child is under 17
3. You provide for more than half of the child's expenses
4. Your child was claimed on your taxes as a Dependent (if you are required to file taxes)

Both spouses need SSNs valid for employment

I am married; we file jointly.

I file as head of household.

Single Taxpayers

If your **joint** income is **less than \$150,000**, you will receive \$2,400.
If your **joint** income is **between \$150,001 - \$198,000**, you will receive *some money but not the full amount.**

If your income is **less than \$112,500**, you will receive \$1,200.
If your income is **between \$112,501 - \$136,500**, you will receive *some money, but not the full amount.**

If your income is **less than \$75,000**, you will receive \$1,200.
If your income is **between \$75,001 - \$99,000**, you will receive *some money, but not the full amount.**

*Your payment will be **reduced** by:
5% x ([your income] - [income cut-off for full payment])

If your **joint** income is **above \$150,001**, you may receive *some money, but not the full amount.**

If your income is **less than \$112,500**, you will receive **an extra \$500** per child.
If your income is **above \$112,501**, you may receive *some money, but not the full amount.**

If your income is **less than \$75,000**, you will receive **an extra \$500** per child.
If your income is **above \$75,001**, you may receive *some money, but not the full amount.**

*Your payment will be **reduced** by:
5% x ([your income] - [income cut-off for full payment])
